EXPLANATIONS OF CODES

Code explanations and other information:

SRS -The School recommendations scheme is a scheme where the students ask their school to recommend them for courses. It is suggested that all students tick this option.

Early Bird applications close on the 30th of September if the students do not submit their form by this date they need to pay \$215.00 as opposed to \$82.00 if they pay by the early bird date.

Students are not encouraged to apply for the same course at university as they do on the UAC form. C.O.P. means change of preferences close. This is because students can change their course choices up until a certain time. The time when they are finally locked in is 6th November. They are opened again for a window of time and then closed again on the 18th of December.

Rounds being released means once the HSC results arrive on the 18th of December universities will send offers of positions in their courses. If a student does not get straight into their chosen course they may get into that course on the second round of offers.

This is a sorting process and means that all places hope to be filled in the universities.
